background Information:

- Pirate Party Israel ("PIRATIM") is a registered political party, protected by the Parties Law.
- The Party's registration number is 59-900092-4. Attached please find the official certification.
- A registration request was submitted to the Parties Registrar Authority on July 9th, 2012.
- The Party received an officially registered status on September 9th, 2012.



- The party's board consist of ten members:
 - O <u>Dan Birron</u>, born 1939, A musician, worked in Radio since 1960 and as producer and director of many Israeli "Classics" in the Israel Broadcasting Authority since it's establishment in 1967. Candidate to the Mayor of Jerusalem in 2008 on behalf of the Green Leaf Party and bar owner in the center of Jerusalem.
 - o **Guy Briller**, born 1970, an artist-activist, founder of the Self Broadcast Authority.
 - o <u>Sharon Kantor</u>, born 1971, a television writer, director, journalist, actress, musician and former host of various television shows.
 - <u>Reinhardt Sato</u>, born 1972, an all-around artist, consultant, strategic planner and organizer of cultural performances and events.
 - Rafram Chaddad, born 1976, an artist, writer and photographer, coordinator of the Slow Food movement in Israel. In March 2012 was kidnapped in Libya by Gaddafi's forces and was subjected to torture for five months, his memoirs published as a story-cookbook recently.
 - <u>Lidia Maletin</u>, born 1978, Producer, Administrative and General Manager of various cultural events, associations and a social activist.
 - Moran Gutman, born 1978, a multi-disciplinary artist, founder of the "No Coast" group a collective of artists and musicians in Jerusalem.
 - Ohad Shem-Tov, born 1979, Computer and Political Scientist, Former head of the "Green Leaf" party and the "Holocaust Survivors and the Grown-Up Green Leaf" Party. Candidate to the Prime Minister of Israel in 2009.
 - Noam Kuzar, born 1981, Producer, Cameraman and Cultural entrepreneur. Former spokesman for the Green Leaf Party.
 - Narkis Tepler, born 1986, a DJ, actress and model, LGBT activist and producer of independent documentaries.
